## Leadership of the Committee

This year started with challenges in both administration and leadership. In order to be able to access the deposits of the former account holder, late llona Graenitz, an association had to be founded under Austrian law. The statutes were submitted for approval on November 11, 2022 to the Austrian authorities. Since December 16, 2022 the Committee is officially registered in the Austrian register of associations ("Vereinsregister") under number 1242799274. This was also the precondition for being able to set up a corresponding account.

In January 2023 we elected a new board and finalized the transfer to the new account in March 2023. Our secretary and webmaster Roland Leithenmayer passed away end of March. So, the Committee had to elect a new secretary in May and look for a new webmaster.

The Committee lost unexpectedly two dedicated members, who were very much involved in Committee activities:

Marlene Parenzan (IBPW) passed away on December 25, 2022. She chaired the nominating committee for the elections in January 2023. We are missing her strategic, international and articulate thinking, as well as her wealth of information about UNO matters. She was a mainstay of the Committee and the Vienna NGO community.

On March 26, 2023, we lost our secretary Roland Leithenmayer (VfV). He served as deputy secretary from 2016 to 2020. In 2016 he set up the website and supervised it continuously. He was passionate about creating a platform for the exchange of knowledge on topics related to sustainable development.

Thanks to outstanding solidarity and commitment of the board and the members we were able to solve the problems and can look back on successful activities.

## Aims and objectives of the Committee

As a substantive committee of the Conference of Non-governmental Organisations (NGOs) in Consultative Relationship with the United Nations, the aims of the Committee are to:

- a) Focus on the environmental, social and economic dimensions of sustainable development.
- b) Provide a forum for NGOs interested in discussing and analysing the work of the UN intergovernmental bodies active in the field of sustainable development, as well as in related activities of the Vienna-based UN organisations.

- c) Encourage new initiatives and seek input into civil society's contribution to the 17 Sustainable Development Goals adopted by the United Nations in September 2015.
- d) Facilitate liaison with the United Nations organisations and agencies working in the field of sustainable development.

#### Membership of the Committee

Currently the Committee on Sustainable Development has 30 member organisations with each organisation having at least on representative. The amount of the annual general membership fee is 30,-- EUR.
